ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KIWANIS CLUB OF CAPITAL CITY, TALLAHASSEE, INC.

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SECRETARY OF STATE
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

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WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, incorporators, hereby associate ourselves together to form and establish a corporation not for profit, under the laws of the State of Florida.

I

The name of this corporation shall be KIWANIS CLUB OF CAPITAL CITY, TALLAHASSEE, INC.

II

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
2. To encourage the daily living of the golden rule in all human relations.
3. To promote the adoption and application of higher social, business, and professional standards.
4. To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive, and serviceable citizenship.
5. To provide through this club a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service, and to build better communities.
6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which makes possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.
7. For the purposes aforesaid, to take over the assets, rights, and franchises of the unincorporated club known as the Kiwanis Club of Capital City, Tallahassee, and its members.
8. To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

III

Qualifications of members are: They must be men of good character and community standing, residing in or having interests in the community, and who are engaged in recognized lines of business, agricultural, institutional and professional life, as owners, partners, executives, corporate officers, managers with administrative duties and discretionary authority, or district or local agents or branch representatives having executive authority, or who are engaged in any worthy and recognized profession for which they have received the recognized standard education; or who, having been so engaged, shall have retired.

IV

The manner of admission of members shall be by election of two-thirds vote of the entire Board of Directors.

V

The term for which this corporation is to exist is-- perpetual.

VI

The affairs of the corporation are to be managed by-- a Board of Directors, which shall be composed of the President, Immediate Past President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and nine members.

The Board of Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the corporation to serve for the calendar year commencing January 1.
